Referencing

- When you conduct your research, you will be expected to reference where your information came from
- Referencing is an important skill that you will use more and more throughout your educational career

Types of references

- Secondary
- Tertiary

Harvard referencing

- Most colleges and universities use the Harvard style of referencing, which looks like this:
- For Books
- McHugh, J., Attwood, S. (2008). Science Is Great. Third Edition. McGraw-Hill, USA
- For Websites
- McHugh, J. (2000). 'How To Write References'. URL: <http://www.referencingfordummies.co.uk/harvard/doesnotexist>.
